Supplementary Regulations

1. This is a National B Sporting Trial held under the general regulations of the M.S.A. Ltd. incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the F.I.A. these supplementary regulations and any other written instructions the promoting club may issue.
2. M.S.A. permit no. 55771
3. The event is a qualifying round for the BTRDA Sporting Trial Championship
4. The trial is open to all members of the promoting club, B.T.R.D.A. and Northern Phoenix Trials Car Club. All competitors must be in possession of a current M.S.A. Licence or Club membership card appropriate for this type of event, which must be produced for inspection at signing on. All passengers must be a member of one of the above clubs.
5. The Trial will be held at Malkin Hill, Shelford Lodge Farm, Shelford, Nottingham NG12 1EA. MR 129/653 410
6. Starting time 10.30 a.m. Competitors must sign on 15 minutes before the start time. The trial will consist of minimum of three rounds of at least eight sections. Scrutineering will start at 9.00a.m.
7. There will be three classes, Red, Blue and Green, competitors will be classified according to the BTRDA Formula. A competitor may only be in one class.
8. Cars must comply with the MSA National Trials Formula and be passed by the scrutineer. Tyre pressures will be a minimum 2 p.s.i. This may be altered according to site conditions, at the discretion of the clerk of the course

9. Tyre pressures will be checked at scrutineering, and spot checks will be made during the day. A brake and differential test will be made before the start of the trial
10. Entries will not exceed 45 and there will be a minimum entry of 20. Double drives will be permitted
11. Closing date for entries is TUESDAY 16TH FEBRUARY 2010 entries should be made on the official entry form and sent to the secretary of the meeting, accompanied by the entry fee of **£30.00** cheques payable to Loughborough Car Club Limited
