

## Walsingham Sporting Trial Supplementary Regulations

- 1) **The 750 Motor Club Ltd, Trials Centre** will organise a **combined National B & Clubsports** permit sporting car trial on **Sunday the 7<sup>th</sup> March 2010 at JACKSON'S WOOD, HAYMANS HILL, HORSMONDEN, KENT, TN12 8BX**
- 2) The meeting will be governed by the General Regulations of the MSA Ltd (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FISA), 2010. these supplementary regulations and any written instructions that the organising club may issue for the event.
- 3) RAC MSA permits have been applied for.
- 4) The event is open to members of the 750 Motor Club, Sporting Trials.com, registered contenders of the ASWMC Richard Egger Insurance Sporting Trials Championship and all clubs with BTRDA status.
- 5) **THIS TRIAL IS A ROUND OF THE 2010 MSA. 750MCLtd. BTRDA, Sporting Trials.com and ASWMC Championships.** All drivers must produce a valid competition licence with photograph and both drivers & passengers a current club membership card of one of these Clubs, unless entered in Clubsports section.
- 6) All competitors & their cars must comply with MSA Technical Regulations & Specific Regulations for Trials 2010.
- 7) The programme of the meeting will be:-  
Scrutineering starts at 9.00am  
Any competitor not signed on by 10.00am may be excluded.  
**First car starts at 10.30am**
- 8) Public roads will not be used to link sections. There will be a minimum of 8 sections to be attempted at least 3 times; details of these sections will be issued at signing on. The entry will be split into groups starting at different hills.
- 9) The event will consist of 4 classes as follows:  
RED BLUE GREEN NOVICE
- 10) Awards will be presented as follows:  
First overall, and first in each class, subject to 6 entries (4 for Novice).  
The Walsingham Annual Cup to the best 750MC driver.
- 11) The entry list opens on the publication of these A.S.R's and closes finally **on Thursday 4<sup>th</sup> March 2010**  
**The entry fee is £35.00**(cheques payable to **The 750 Motor Club** ) entries must be made on the official entry form and accompanies by the full fee & received by **Thursday 4<sup>th</sup> March 2010**  
**DOUBLE DRIVE ENTRIES must have a 3<sup>rd</sup> person as Passenger.**  
**Entry fees** will be cancelled if a competitor notifies the secretary a cancelled entry no later than 12 noon Friday 5<sup>th</sup> March 2010
- 12) Accepted entries will be notified if an E mail address is given

- 14) The maximum entry for the meeting, including reserves, is 55. The minimum entry is 12. The maximum for each class is 30. The minimum is 6. Should any of the above minimum figures not be reached, the organisers have the right to either cancel the meeting or amalgamate classes as necessary. **Entries will be selected in order of receipt.**

- 16) Provisional results will be published and awards presented as soon as possible following the end of the event.
- 17) Protests must be lodged in accordance with section [C (d)] Common Regs
- 18) Starting numbers will be allocated by ballot.
- 19) Competitors will be identified by numbers which will be provided by the organisers.
- 20) Marking and penalties will be as printed in section J Observed Sections MSA Regulations. 2010 and Clarification by the C.o.C at the Drivers Briefing
- 21) For clarity, spinning wheels on a section will be permitted for a count of three seconds after which forward motion will be deemed to have stopped and the marshal will award points at that position as J 20.
- 22) Any driver allowing an unauthorised person, i.e. one who has not signed the official indemnity form for the event, to drive his trials car will be disqualified from the event and the results immediately.
- 23) Provisional results will be available at the close of the meeting and full results will be posted or E mailed to all entrants.
- 25) BTRDA competitors are only permitted to use Vredestein Sprint + or Firestone F560 tyres. Other competitors to comply with current MSA requirements.
- 26) Tyre pressures will be advised at the start and may be checked during the event. The CoC may require pressures to be amended by up to 5 lbs/sq.in during the Trial.
